  - by performance level,
  - with a comparison between annual objectives and actual performance for each student group, and
  - including the percentage of each group of students not tested
- Graduation rates for secondary school students
- Performance of our district and campuses on adequate yearly progress (AYP) measures
- Number and names of Title I schools identified as "in need of improvement", including the stage of improvement and AYP indicator missed for any schools identified for improvement (Barbers Hill ISD has **no** campuses "in need of improvement")
- Professional qualifications of teachers in the district and campuses, including the percentage of teachers teaching with emergency or provisional credentials and the percentage of classes in the district and campuses that are not taught by highly qualified teachers, including a comparison between high- and low-poverty campuses within the LEA (**all** teachers in Barbers Hill ISD are highly qualified).
