Barbers Hill High School Parking Permits

All students who operate a motor vehicle, to include a motorcycle, on school property are required to register their vehicles with the District by purchasing a student parking permit. Student parking permits must be renewed each school year.

Permits may be obtained during online registration and at other times in the high school police office (B160). Permits are \$10.00 from registration through the 30th day of school. The cost increases to \$20.00 after that, unless the student is a newly licensed driver.

Students must show proof of a valid driver's license and proof of financial responsibility (liability insurance) at the time of the permits issuance. Permit applications may be obtained from the BHISD website or room B160 at the High School.

It is the responsibility of the student driver to register his/her vehicle, and to display a valid parking permit for the current school year. Vehicles parked without a valid student parking permit may be towed at the owner's expense and the student is subject to school discipline.

Permit costs are as follows:

Permits \$10.00

(Newly Licensed Drivers have 30 days after they are issued their license to get their parking permit)

After the 30th day of School \$20.00

BHISD Parking & Traffic Safety Regulations

- 1. Drivers parking on school grounds must have a valid driver's license and motor vehicle insurance.
