Barbers Hill Independent School District is a suburban district in western Chambers County. Established in 1929, the district has a rich tradition of community involvement and school pride. The fabric of the district's story is interwoven with that of the petrochemical industry in our area, beginning with the discovery of oil in the early 20th century at the Mont Belvieu Salt Dome, and continuing today as the petrochemical industry expands to meet global demand.

Barbers Hill ISD encompasses four communities: **Mont Belvieu, Old River-Winfree, Cove and Beach City**. We are home to 7 campuses, including one high school, two middle schools, two elementary schools, an Early Childhood Center that includes grades Pre-K to 1, and an alternative disciplinary campus.




Our students in 2019-20




