

Additional Information and/or Back-Up:

The District is preparing for an upcoming bond program to include various facilities construction and improvements, subject to voter approval. Per Texas Government Code §2254.004, §2258.002, and §2258.022, a board of trustees must require that workers on a school construction project be paid "not less than the general prevailing wage rate per diem wages for work of a similar character in the locality in which the work is performed"; Also the board must determine the general prevailing rate of per diem wages in the locality in which the public work is to be performed for each craft or type of worker needed to execute the contract. The proposed rates were determined through local regional surveys in the Gulf Coast Greater Houston Area and procured with the assistance of PBK Architects.

Additional Information and/or Back-Up:

The District is preparing for an upcoming bond program to include various facilities construction and improvements, subject to voter approval. Pursuant to Tex. Gov't Code § 2269.056, the administration recommends that the Board designate construction delivery methods for bond projects as indicated below and that the administration be authorized to develop selection criteria and conduct advertised bid processes for the projects. Upon completion of the bid processes, the administration will bring back recommended vendors for Board approval.

The District will use Construction Manager-At-Risk (CM@R) as the primary procurement delivery system for construction. CM@R is a sole proprietorship, partnership, corporation, or other legal entity that assumes the risk for construction, rehabilitation, alteration, or repair of a facility at the contracted price as a general contractor and provides consultation to the school district regarding construction during and after the design of a facility.

The Following Bond 2020 Projects will use the Construction Manager-At-Risk procurement:

- Intermediate School North
- Intermediate School South
- Elementary School North Additions
- Elementary School South Additions

Recommendation

I move that the Board designate construction delivery methods for upcoming bond projects as presented. I further move that the Board authorize the administration to develop selection criteria for each of the projects presented and to proceed with advertised bid processes for the projects.
